During the mid-1960s, Lou founded Columbia Elevator Products Co. Inc. – named in part to commemorate his father’s fatal material lift accident at Columbia Presbyterian Medical Center in New York – with safety and innovation as his guiding principles. Drawing upon years of experience at the Williamsburg Door Company, in various capacities and ultimately as Chief Engineer, he developed the concept of shipping disassembled elevator door and entrance assemblies for erection on the job site, an important safety innovation on the historically-dangerous open construction site. After striking out on his own in 1967, his new business model became a major success that grew to eventually revolutionize the industry. By the early 1970s, it became clear that the manufacture and installation of elevator cabs required similar innovation, and Lou brought his revolutionary thinking to this area as well. Today, from his Chairman’s seat on the Board of Directors, Lou keeps a fatherly eye on Columbia, providing wise counsel as the company continues to bring his vision to solutions for the elevator industry’s ongoing needs.
